

## LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### April 2019

- For April 2019, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **6,429**, down **85** cases compared to March 2019's **6,514** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for April 2019 are **1,477**, down **54** case compared to March 2019's **1,531** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for April 2019 are **4,952**, down **31** cases compared to March 2019's **4,983** cases.
- Total support service payments for April 2019 totaled **\$248,779**, up **\$33,282** from March 2019's **\$215,497**.
- From December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2001 through April 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019, **3,367** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,979** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **853** of which were approved (for a **43.1%** approval rate).

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## **Characteristics of the Current WV WORKS Caseload**

**April 2019**

- √ **4,952** Child-only cases ---- parents not in the home and children living with a relative, or parents in the home, are receiving Medicaid and are excluded from the WV WORKS payment.
- √ **86** Cases currently receiving WV WORKS and received TANF in another state before moving to West Virginia.
- √ **107** Cases where parents are excluded from the payment due to being convicted of a drug-related felony after August 22, 1996.
- √ **6,197** Cases receiving Medicaid but not SNAP.
- √ **183** Cases receiving SNAP but adults not receiving Medicaid.
- √ **221** Adults receiving WV WORKS and are employed.
