

LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

February 2016

- For February 2016, WV WORKS cases statewide increased to **7,657**, up **31** cases compared to January 2016's **7,626** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for February 2016 are **2,805**, up **2** cases compared to January 2016's **2,803** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for February 2016 are **4,852**, up **29** cases compared to January 2016's **4,823** cases.
- Total support service payments for February 2016 totaled **\$305,760**, down **\$25,873** from January 2016's **\$331,633**.
- From December 1st, 2001 through February 29th, 2016, **3,157** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit. Of that amount, **1,888** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **802** of which were approved (for a **42.5%** approval rate).

February 2016

- √ **4,852** Child-only cases ---- parents not in the home and children living with a relative, or parents in the home, are receiving Medicaid and are excluded from the WV WORKS payment.
- √ **64** Cases currently receiving WV WORKS and received TANF in another state before moving to West Virginia.
- √ **105** Cases where parents are excluded from the payment due to being convicted of a drug-related felony after August 22, 1996.
- √ **3,859** Cases receiving Medicaid but not SNAP.
- √ **78** Cases receiving SNAP but adults not receiving Medicaid.
- √ **403** Adults receiving WV WORKS and are employed.
