**Four (4)** TANF cases were closed in January 2022 due to reaching the 60-month maximum assistance time-limit. The total number of cases closed for this reason is **3,528**. **One (1)** family was approved for an extension beyond 60 months, which results in a total of **889** extensions granted to date.
