

## LOCHHRA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### July 2025

- For July 2025, WV WORKS cases statewide decreased to **4,439**, down **17** cases, compared to June 2025's **4,456** cases.
- Adult WV WORKS cases statewide for July 2025 are **1,225**, up **6** cases, compared to June 2025's **1,219** cases.
- Child-only cases statewide for July 2025 are **3,214**, down **23** cases, compared to June 2025's **3,237** cases.
- Total support service payments for July 2025 totaled **\$164,763**, down **\$3,190** from June 2025's **\$167,953**.

From December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2001, through July 31st, 2025, **3,683** WV WORKS cases have closed due to the adult(s) reaching the 60-month limit of that amount, **2,127** customers requested an extension of benefits up to an additional 6-month period; **914** of which were approved (for a **43.0%** approval rate).
